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A degree in Information Technology (ITY) will prepare students to use a wide array of technologies available to solve real-world problems that might occur in any discipline or organization. Emphasis is placed on software engineering, database design and management, computer networking, system support and administration, human computer interaction, and storage management. Students learn to balance the theory, practice and communication of information technology concepts through active learning strategies in a laboratory setting and presentation of their work to others in a variety of public forums. Important themes such as Business Continuity and Information Availability, Security, Virtualization and Cloud Computing are emphasized in many courses.

Majors must earn a grade of C- or better in all CSC/ITY courses.
