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The Education Curriculum Studies Major encompasses a thorough foundational knowledge base of educational theory and appropriate curriculum for the specified area of concentration. The student will be prepared to work in various school settings in a support capacity, but not as a certified teacher, as well as being prepared for a number of additional careers, including youth programming in social services, recreational services, or educational sales. Students will participate in a practicum component doing fieldwork in a school setting, and will pursue writing and speech intensive coursework necessary to success in any field.

**\*Concentration Area:** Students are also required to complete *at least 18 hours* in one education concentration area, Math, Science, English, Social Science, Business, Physical Education, or Spanish.

Majors must have a 2.0 GPA or better in all courses presented to satisfy the major requirements. No course with a grade below a 'D' will be accepted.
